

# Utilities and Community Facilities

## Major Findings

1. The community has done very well in minimizing stormwater infiltration into the sanitary sewer system.
2. Both the water and the sanitary sewer system have capacity for reasonable community growth
3. Fire protection in the future will continue to require close cooperation with other governments.

## Goal, Objectives, and Policies

### Goal

- To provide community facilities and services that are well maintained and sufficient for the needs of the residents of St. Cloud, working with the private sector and surrounding communities when it is beneficial.

### Objectives

1. Provide adequate police and fire protection to all areas of the village.
2. Maintain high quality sewer and water services to limit the Village's liability and preserve public health.
3. Village utilities have done a good job of addressing stormwater infiltration in sanitary sewer lines. This effort will need to continue with new sanitary sewer lines.
4. Maintain parkland and recreation programs that will provide existing and future residents of all ages with adequate, safe, convenient, high quality recreational opportunities.

### Policies

1. The Village of St. Cloud should meet annually with surrounding communities to determine how services and equipment can be shared.
2. Monitor wells and sewer lines to ensure appropriate action to identify and prioritize needed improvements and correct deficiencies.
3. With the exception of remote physical sites, private wells and septic tanks are not encouraged in the village.

**Sewer Service Area Plan**

- ❑ Sewer Service Area (SSA) Plans are required under Wisconsin Administrative Code [NR-121](#) to assist in maintaining and improving water quality within the state by outlining areas which are able to accommodate sewer development in a well-managed environment, and delineating environmentally sensitive areas which preclude such development.
- ❑ SSA Plans also serve as the long-term plan (20-40 years) for the community’s wastewater treatment plant and collection infrastructure, and are used as guidance during the Facilities Planning process established under Wisconsin Administrative Code [NR-110](#).
- ❑ No SSA Plan has been deemed necessary for St. Cloud, nor is one expected to be required in the foreseeable future. Such plans are prepared in this area by the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission.
