

VILLAGE BOARD OF ST CLOUD
TUESDAY, MAY 5, 2015

The regular monthly meeting of the Village Board of St. Cloud was called to order by President Ryan Gebhart at 7 pm. All board members were present. The minutes of last months meeting were read and a motion was made by Troy Johnson and seconded by Tom Tabbert to approve them as read. Motion carried. The minutes were read from a special meeting held on April 21, 2015. A motion was made by Dave Schry and seconded by Jeff Horn to approve them. Motion passed.

Utility Business: MCO was not present, but reported that the discharge sampling is showing good results. A new temperature gauge for the discharge manhole was purchased. While Dale is off for surgery, MCO and Dean will be doing the rounds. Steve Thiede will be helping with the mowing. A motion was made by Dave Schry and seconded by Mike Born to approve the termination of services letter to SMS effective 5-5-15. Motion passed.

Village Business: Skyler, a boy scout from the village presented his dog park eagle scout project to the board. The board to review the proposed area at the park. Mary to check with the insurance company regarding liability issues and get back to him.

The final draft of the Sewer Agreement and the proposed Manure Ordinance were reviewed by the board. A motion was made by Dave Schry and seconded by Troy Johnson to approve them. Motion passed. Mary to take care of the publications and place them on next month's agenda.

Mike Born presented the LRIP plans for West Barrett Street. A motion was made by Jeff Horn and seconded by Dave Schry to go forward. Motion carried. Mike to place ad for bids on May 19 and 20. Bids to be open at the June meeting. The streets and sidewalk committee noted that a pipe was broken on the catch basin on Barrett Street. It should be fixed before the road is repaired.

The Lorraine Kohlman family has donated money toward Main Street flag banners to be presented at the grand opening of our improved Main Street project in 2019.

A motion was made by Tom Tabbert and seconded by Dan Dreifuertst to approve the proposal from Feldner Construction to repair the frost damage at the Village Park. Motion passed. A new tree will be purchased and planted at the park from Busy Acres.

After reviewing the lighting in the village firehouse and village hall, a motion was made by Jeff Horn and seconded by Tom Tabbert to purchase 2 cases of light bulbs and replace all exit lights with energy efficient LED lights. Motion carried. Also approved was new lighting at the village garage and a possible service upgrade.

New signs will be ordered for the recycle center.
Time Cards were reviewed.
A motion was made and seconded to pay the monthly bills.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 9 pm.
