Sec. 10-1-112 FENCE STANDARDS

- (a) RESIDENTIAL FENCES are permitted on the property lines in residential districts but shall not in any case exceed a height of six (6) feet; shall not exceed a height of four (4) feet in the street yard and shall not be closer than two (2) feet to any public right –of –way.
- (b) SECURITY FENCES are permitted on the property lines in all districts except residential districts but shall not exceed ten (10) feet in height and shall be of an open type similar to woven wire or wrought iron fencing.
- (c) PROHIBITED FENCES. No fence shall be constructed which conducts electricity or is designed to electrically shock or which uses barbed wire; provided, however that barbed wire to the fence are ten (10) feet above the ground or higher and project toward the fenced property and away from any public area.
- (d) FENCES TO BE REPAIRED. All fences shall be maintained and kept safe and in a state of good repair, and finished side or decorative side of a fence shall face adjoining property.
