

CHAPTER 4
ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE OPERATION
VILLAGE OF ST. CLOUD, FOND DU LAC COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL VILLAGE STREETS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE LIMITS OPEN FOR
ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE OPERATION AND REGULATING THE
OPERATION OF SUCH VEHICLES ON THESE STREETS

Section I – Intent 8.4.1

The Village of St. Cloud, Fond du Lac County, adopts the following ordinance in order that all-terrain vehicles may be operated upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this ordinance has been created for public use.

Section II – Statutory Authority 8.4.2

This ordinance is created pursuant to village authority under section 8.4.01.

Section III – Routes 8.4.3

The following streets (only within the village limits) are designated as routes:

- A. South Street
- B. Church Street
- C. Marsh Street
- D. Barrett Street
- E. Railroad Avenue
- F. Thorp Street
- G. Gordon Street
- H. Clark Street
- I. North Street
- J. Cedarview Drive
- K. Rusmar Road
- L. River Lane
- M. Main Street

Section IV – Conditions 8.4.4

As a condition for the use of these streets the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV operators shall observe a speed limit of 10 miles per hour.

- B. All ATV operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV operators under the age of 16 are required to have a safety certificate.

Section V – Enforcement 8.4.5

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin

Section VI – Penalties 8.4.6

Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s.23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VII – Severability 8.4.7

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village of St. Cloud would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deem affected.

Section VIII – Effective Date 8.4.8

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
