

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT
VILLAGE OF ST. CLOUD

Any qualified voter who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day, April 7, 2020, may submit a request to vote an absentee ballot to the municipal clerk.

The voter must be a registered voter in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

You may make a request for an absentee ballot in writing or by email, stating your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where you would like the ballot sent, and your signature. You may also make a request online at MyVote.wi.gov.

The deadline for making an application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is: April 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

If you prefer to request and/or vote an absentee ballot in person at the clerk's office at the Village Hall, 1105 Main Street, please call the number below to make arrangements.
