**Amendment to Regulation of Parks Ordinance Relating to Animals allowed in
Village Parks and Property**

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of St. Cloud, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, with quorum present and voting, hereby ordains the following amendments to the Village of St. Cloud Ordinance relating Regulation of Parks:

Sec. 4-5-1(b)(3) is amended to read:

Animals.

- (i) No person shall bring animals into Village Park located at 915 Main Street and adjacent parcels of property.
- (ii) Except as provided in subsection 4-5-1(b)(3)(i) above, no person shall bring animals into a park or property owned by the Village, with the exception of leashed dogs on roads, paved trails, and chipped or gravel paths.
- (iii) Dogs brought into a park or property owned by the Village must be licensed, and have a current rabies vaccination per state law. Such dogs must wear owner identification tags at all times.
- (iv) All dogs brought into a park or property owned by the Village must be on a leash. Aggressive dogs must be removed from the park or Village property. The person bringing a dog into the park or Village property is responsible for the actions and behavior of the dog. The person bringing a dog into the park or Village property may never leave the dog unattended. The person bringing a dog into the park or Village property is responsible for the behavior and control of the dog while at the park or Village property.
- (v) This subsection shall not apply to certified guide dogs that are under control by the use of a harness or other restraint and are accompanying blind, deaf or mobility impaired persons, as provided under Wis. Stats. § 174.056.


All other provisions of the Village of St. Cloud Ordinance relating Regulation of Parks remain in full force and effect.

The Village Clerk and Village Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary to implement this Ordinance.
