CHAPTER 1

Miscellaneous Utilities Regulations

§ 5-1-1 Additional Laterals to the Sewer and Water Utility System; Fees

SEC. 5-1-1 ADDITIONAL LATERALS TO THE SEWER AND WATER UTILITY SYSTEM; FEES.

- (a) All additional laterals to the sewer and water system can be made only after a permit has been obtained from the Utilities Commission. The cost of each such permit shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.
- (b) All costs of the construction and connection to the Sewer and Water Utility of additional laterals shall be paid by the property owner.
- (c) All work shall be done by a master plumber who holds a permit from the Utilities Commission and has filed a Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars plumber's bond.
- (d) If the lateral is on Main Street, an additional permit to open Main Street for a lateral must be obtained from the Fond du Lac County Highway Commission.
- (e) The following regulations shall apply to the installation and connection of such laterals:
 - (1) Only stop boxes as specified by the Utility Commission may be used.
 - (2) The saddle on the main sewer shall be as specified by the Sewer Utility.
 - (3) The water tap must be made under the immediate supervision of a master plumber.
 - (4) The plumber in charge must backfill according to the rules of the Wisconsin Public Service Commission Rate File Schedule X-1.5 Amendment 1.
- (f) Before the excavation shall be covered or a final connection placed in service for either sewer and water, such work shall be inspected by the duly authorized representative of the Utilities Commission. The plumber in charge shall give the Utilities Commission a proper notice that such work is about to be completed.
